Cetacean & Seabird Identification Workshop

1st Evening

Welcome & Introductory presentation – your opportunity to meet the team and find out all about the course.

This will be followed by a presentation introducing you to the fantastic world of cetaceans and seabirds. We will be covering cetacean and seabird taxonomy, the species likely to be encountered in the English Channel and Bay of Biscay, topography of the region, distribution etc.

Southbound Day

The morning session will be classroom based, covering observation and identification of cetaceans & seabirds at sea, survey protocols and an introduction to Marinelife survey forms. This will be followed by a hands-on interactive workshop utilising video and photographs to hone your observation and identification skills before we head out on to deck for the remainder of the day. Utilising 'Monkey Island', a dedicated deck available to us allowing forward viewing, we will be putting into practice all those skills covered in the morning session.

In the evening we reconvene for a short debrief and round up of the day. This will include a Q&A session.

Northbound Day 1

After a morning in Spain, we rejoin the ship and head straight up onto the decks for departure ready for another busy day observing and recording cetaceans and seabirds at sea.

Again, in the evening we reconvene for a debrief and round up.

Northbound Day 2

Our final day at sea will see us on deck early in the morning to monitor the Western Approaches and southern English Channel until early afternoon.

In the afternoon, we will have a final presentation to round up the trip. This will include a discussion of the sightings we have had, a round up of the trip as a whole and information about becoming a Marinelife surveyor.

Then it is time to head up on to deck for one final time to watch our approach to Portsmouth and bid farewell to the friends we have made on the trip.
